Items you may NOT bring: sheath, hunting, or switchblade knives, fireworks, slingshots, firearms, air rifles, tube tents, portable music, electronic games, alcohol, drugs, or school books. Troop arranges camp permits, tour permits, and parking pass for all field trips.
